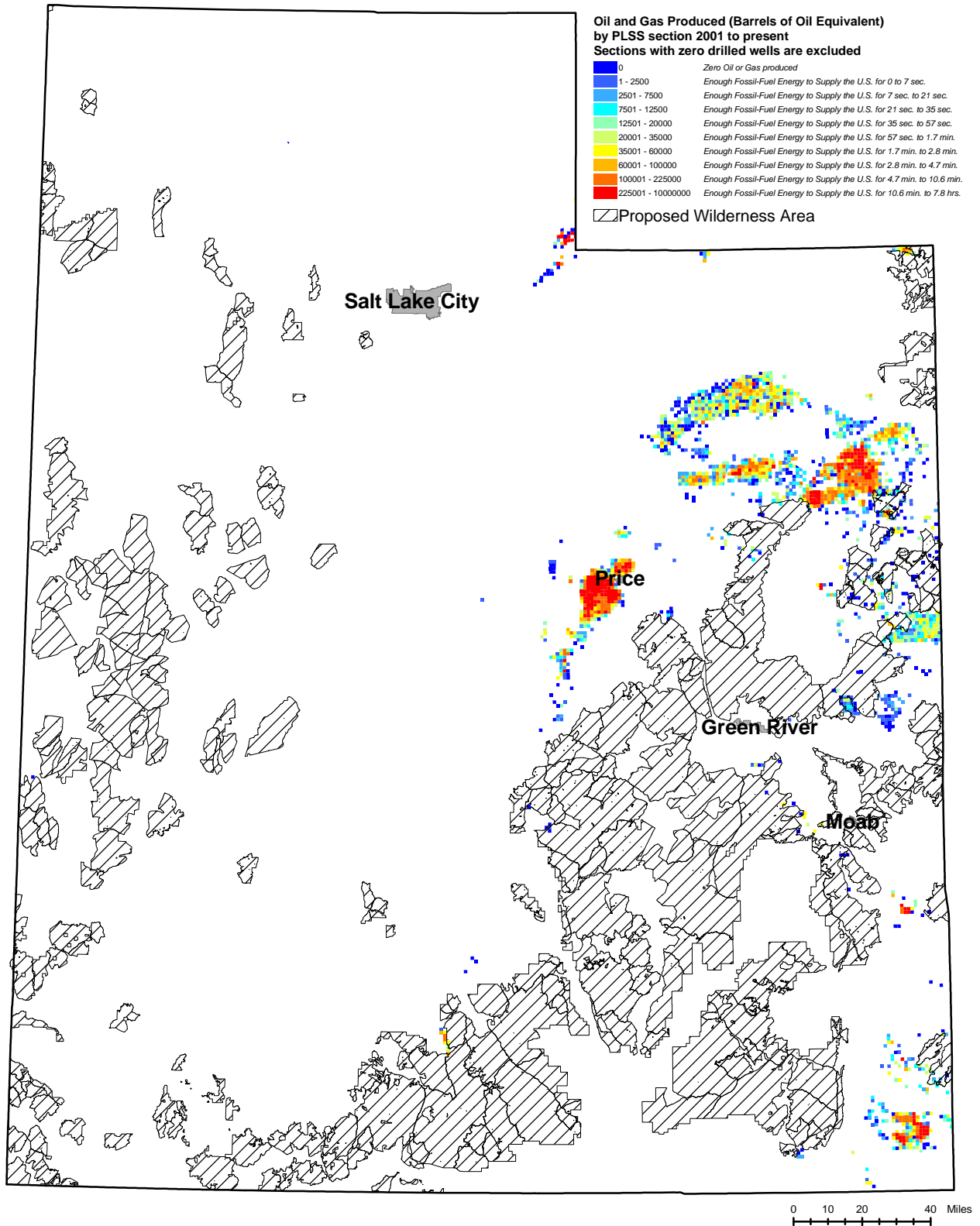


Figure 4: Recent Utah oil and gas production: 2001 to present



Statewide cumulative production of oil and gas 2001 to present is 0.170 billion barrels of oil equivalent (BBOE): enough to supply the United States' fossil-fuel energy needs for 5.6 days
